Thankfully there was no devastation or serious injury. I believe God protected us, and for that we are extremely grateful. We are also grateful that most of our churches, and homes suffered little to no damage. Pastor Will Asavio leads our Jesus Is Lord, Samoan church in Anchorage. The building they rent had about \$3,000. in damage that the church repaired. Pastor Bobby and Linda Jones at Harvest Christian Fellowship have had the most loss. Pastor Bobby reports nearly \$35,000. in damage at the church. The Jones' also had some damage at their home, including the loss of most of Linda's prized antique glass collection. Several churches have sent an offering to help Harvest Christian Fellowship and the Jones'. I hope you will consider sending them a love offering. You may send it to the Alaska/BC office or directly to Pastor Jones. We will gladly give World Missions credit for any donations.

ARCTICFEST 2019

There has always been something about youth conferences that allows teens to become more spiritually connected. This year, Arcticfest 2019 was no different. As Kyle Quinn and the Unashamed Band began with incredibly anointed worship, there was a sense that somehow this conference was going to be different. There was a sense that God was going to do more in their lives by reaching depths not yet touched and freeing years of hurt and sorrow so that restoration could be experienced. Main Speaker Rob Miskowski, current pastor of Intentional Church in Shreveport, Louisiana, and former Louisiana State Youth Director, then began to speak on the purpose of the Holy Spirit and why it is needed today. In the end, there were 5 kids saved and 7 filled with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues.

One of most engaging moments was during a testimonial time, as the kids began to share how God touched them. Some described moments of coming to terms with forgiveness, others on how they had that "God-moment" during prayer. Our belief is that because of this, God is raising pastors, teachers, and missionaries.

Of course, we also had fun. Lots of games, but most seem to enjoy the simple time of sledding down the hill. Others chose to enjoy painting and other arts.

The final word to the kids was that the real work now begins. A recent study noted that

young adults who stay in church continue because they developed the habit of reading His Word and prayer. Our encouragement to them to do this, not out of obligation, will continue to seal what the Holy Spirit has begun.
